Obstetric care provided through birth centers improves maternal and infant results and reduces costs for medicalid beneficiaries. birth centers offer a number of birth options and have resources for the care of patients with medical and psychosocial risks. addressing the barriers identified in this study would promote the participation of birth centers in medicaid, leading to better results for mothers and infants covered by medicaid and significant savings for the medical program. context: the care of the midwives, especially when offered through birth centers, has shown the promise to both improve the results of pregnancy and to contain costs. the national evaluation of strong start for mothers and infants ii, an initiative that has tested the improved prenatal care models for medical beneficiaries, has found that women receiving prenatal care at the birth centers of strong start have experienced higher birth results than the combined counterparts and regulated in the typical medical care. We use qualitative evaluation data to investigate the experiences of birth centers participating in medicaid, and identify policies that influence access of medical beneficiaries to obstetrics and birth centers. methods: we have analyzed the data from over 200 interviews of informantsand 40 focus groups conducted during four study shifts; a phone-based survey of Medicaid officials in Strong Start states; and an internet survey of birth center sites. We have identified issues related to access toand birth centers, focusing on influential medical policies. results: medicalid beneficiaries chose birth center care because they preferred ostetric suppliers, wanted a more natural birth experience, or in some cases sought some pain relief methods or birth procedures not available in hospitals. However, medical enrollments currently have less access to birth centers than privately insured women. Many birth centers have difficulty in contracting with managed care organizations and participating in medical value-based delivery system reforms, and birth center refund rates are sometimes too low to cover the actual cost of care. Some birth centers significantly limit medical activity due to low refund rates and threats to the sustainability of structures.
